This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- ⇒ The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Nepra) allows power distribution companies (Discos) to collect an additional 4.921 rupees per unit from consumers in their April 2024 bills on account of fuel adjustment charges.
- The federal government approves a 105-kilometer railway line connecting Port Qasim in Karachi to coalfield blocks in Tharparkar to facilitate coal transportation for power generation.
- ⇒ Dasu hydropower project in northern Pakistan receives one billion US dollars in loans from the World Bank. The project is projected to generate 2,160 megawatts of electricity.
- The federal government's Engineering Development Board (EDB) issues 34 licenses to the manufacturers of electric motorcycles and rickshaws.
