May 20th - 26th, 2024

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) approves K-Electric's Power Acquisition Program for years 2024-28, focusing on renewable energy integration, local fuel, and power offtake from the national grid.
- The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) reduces gas prices by 10 percent citing surplus revenue generation.
- Awais Ahmad Khan Leghari, Federal Minister for Energy, says solar net-metering policy will be retained for existing consumers but it will be revised after thorough stakeholder consultations.
- Jiang Zaidong, the Chinese Ambassador to Pakistan, announces that China has so far invested 25.4 billion US dollars in Pakistan under the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). The money has been used for building roads, producing electricity, and setting up electricity transmission networks.
- Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif orders the appointment of officers from the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) and intelligence agencies as deputy directors in power distribution companies (Discos) to curb corruption.
