June 10th - 16th, 2024

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- Suki Kinari, a mega hydropower project, located in Mansehra district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province and financed by Chinese investors under the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), enters its wet testing phase.
- Sindh Transmission & Dispatch Company (STDC) and Go Energy Private Limited sign a Memorandum of Understanding to develop the first floating solar energy project with a 550-megawatt capacity on Kinjhar Lake in Sindh province. Electricity produced by the project will be provided to K-Electric.
- The United States International Development Finance Corporation (DFC) refuses to make further investments in Pakistan's energy sector until the tariff structures of existing wind power projects are revised.
- The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Nepra) announces a 5.72 rupees per unit increase in electricity tariffs for fiscal year 2024-25 to provide an additional revenue of 3.6 trillion rupees to the electricity distribution companies (Discos).
